Wow! We've already completed the entire first month of Grade One! It always amazes me how quickly the time goes each day, each week, and now each month.

## **Spelling Tests**

Just a reminder you DO NOT need to return the spelling test each week. Corrections should definitely be made on words that are either spelled incorrectly or printed incorrectly, but <u>I do not need to see</u> those corrections. Remember to refer to the class website for creative ways to practice spelling words. **The class website also has the spelling list for the entire year.** 

Also, while they are practicing, please watch how your child is:

- Holding their pencil.
- Forming the letters. Letters and numbers should ALWAYS be started at the top! We are talking a lot about tall letters, small letters and letters that fall.

## **Theme**

Our theme for the month of October is "Thanks!"

As one of our ways to celebrate Thanksgiving in a fun way, we are asking you to work with your child to disguise the turkey that came home today so that he doesn't become turkey dinner! Over the years some VERY creative submissions have been turned in. This is an activity that you **can** work on with them, so have fun! When my children were in grade one I think I had more fun with this than he did! (Note: the turkey is also at the end of this newsletter if you want to print it out.) \*Feel free to send it in at any time this month. We will hang them up to display for the class.\*



### **Read In Week**

October 7-11 is "Read In Week". We will be emphasizing reading even more than we already do and participating in some fun activities. On Thursday, Oct 10<sup>th</sup> we will have **Book Character Dress Up Day**. This is only for the Grade 1 & 2 students. Please have your child wear their favourite costume from their favourite book! If their costume doesn't line up with a book, that is totally ok as well. We do ask that costumes are not creepy or gory or evil in any way. We want costumes to line up with the Christian philosophy that we hold dear here at SCE. Also, we do not dress up for Halloween at SCE.

# **Buddy Book Bags PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

Last week, a "Buddy Book Bag" or some Game Bags started coming home each day. These bags will hold books that are at your child's reading level and that they feel comfortable reading to you. Some of you will receive a literacy game for your child to work on. Please build a habit of having your child put the bag and books back into their backpack immediately after reading so that the books are less likely to be misplaced.

The key to having success with learning to read is, in large part, the amount of reading that your child does. The more, the better!!! Your child should be reading their Buddy Books every night and exchanging them for new books every day.

## PLEASE SEND THESE BOOKS BACK EVERY DAY!!!!!

If you notice the same books coming home day after day, please let me know. We allow the kids to choose their own books, but sometimes they try to take the same books every day ③.

Lastly, if these bags become damaged, we will NOT be able to replace them due to cost, so please treat them like they truly are your "Buddy".



## **Guided Reading**

Guided Reading groups will begin after Thanksgiving. The students have been placed in groups based on their individual level of reading. This will be a time for them to read in a small group and have some more direct reading instruction from the teacher. Those students who are not with a teacher on a particular day will be reading to themselves and with a partner.

### **Photo Retakes**

If you are not happy with your child's school photo, picture retakes are on **Thursday, Oct 17**<sup>th</sup>. You should have all of the necessary information on the photo proof that came home on September 19<sup>th</sup>. **Please send a note if they are going to get a retake on that day.** 

Also that day we will have our Class photos taken.



# **Student Pick Up/Appointments etc.**

If you are planning to pick up your child from school on any given day instead of letting them take the school bus, please send a note in your child's mail folder that morning. You can imagine that it is difficult to make a split-second decision when the busses are pulling away as to whether to believe your son or daughter that their parent has told them not to take the bus that day. Students often get messages wrong and then we are making calls home to ask if you would please pick up your son or daughter. This just makes it a whole lot more stressful for both the students and their teachers.
