Dear Parents,

During the first two weeks of school, we allow the children time to settle into grade one, master the routines, and get comfortable in their new learning environment. Part way through September, we will begin a review of the snap words from kindergarten. It is beneficial for the children to spend these first few weeks reviewing so they can transfer this spelling into their written work.

After the four review weeks, the spelling program will change, and students will begin to learn to spell words that are new to them. We call these snap words because we want to know them in a snap.
