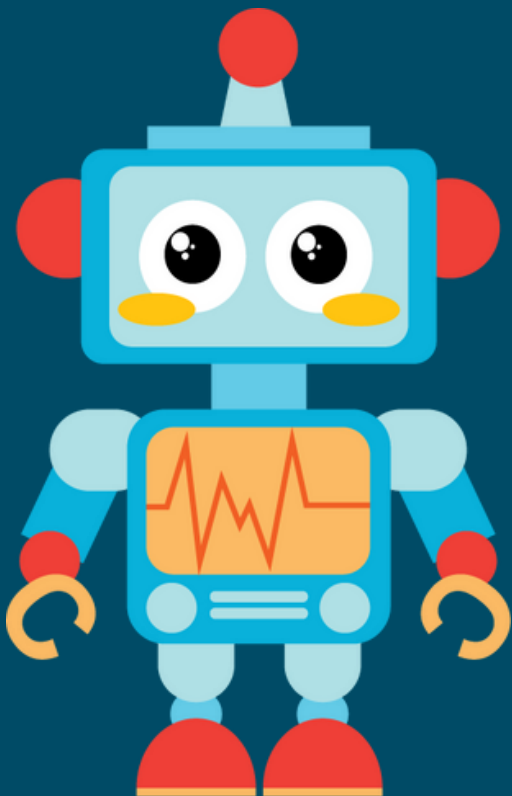
Social Studies
